

HOMEWORK PROJECT

The Study of SHAPES PART 2 of 3 – BUILDING DESIGN

You have chosen your famous building and learned a little more about it. Now it is time to put your architectural hat on and look specifically at the shapes within the building itself.

This week you are required firstly, to find a picture of your chosen famous building. Try to print it at A4 size (the same as this piece of paper) and it can be in black and white or colour. You may also look off of the computer screen to save paper.

Secondly, on a separate piece of A4 paper, recreate your building by drawing in as much detail as possible. Look specifically at the shapes of the building structure, the windows, doorways, roofs, etc., to help you draw what you see. You only need to use a pencil, but you can add any details you'd like after your sketch.

Finally, you are to write a paragraph describing your chosen famous building in as much detail as possible. Think about how you would describe your building to someone who cannot see it. Remember to use lots of adjectives (describing words).

Things that you could describe are:

- Height and width of the building
- Shape of the building/windows/roof
- Colour
- What it is made of
- Is it one main structure or are there features that surround it or are on top of it?
- Does it look like something else you could compare it to?
- Is it impressive? Do you like it? Why?
- If it is an old building: What makes it look old? Are there any areas that have crumbled away or does it still look new?
- If it is new: What makes it look new? Is it very shiny?
