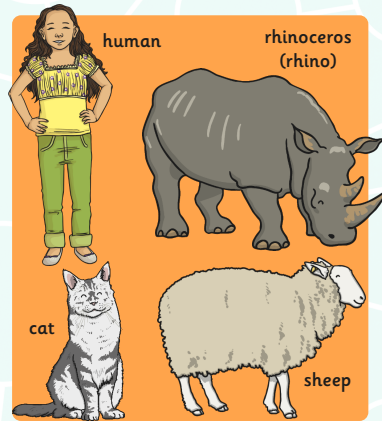


Mammals

What do animals of this kind have in common?

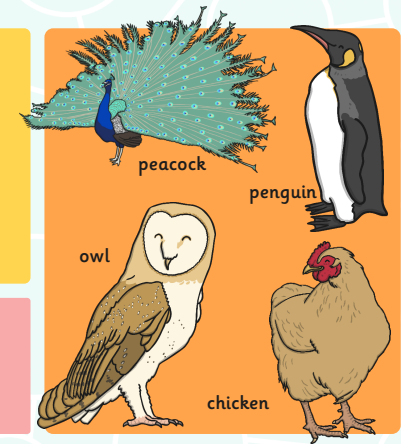

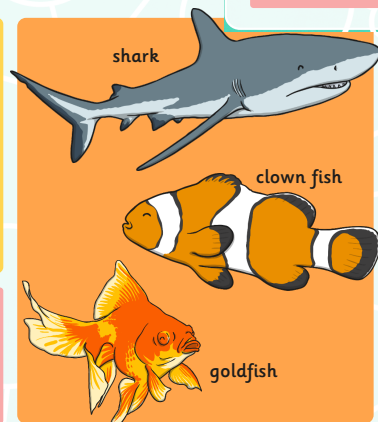
Fish
